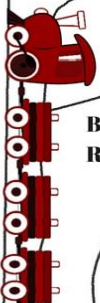

IMPORTANT

These safety rules must be read to each person in your party before going to any activities.

- RULE #1 Children MUST be accompanied by an adult at ALL times!**
- #2** This is a real working and playing ranch. Tell us immediately if you see anything dangerous, or that needs immediate attention.
- #3** Unlimited visits to any activity, however, no saving space or cutting in line. Any activity may be closed at any time for construction, safety or other reasons.
- #4** Our **first aid** station is located in the **General Store**.
- #5** If you have any questions or need help with anything, ask an Oil Ranch employee. Our first concern is safety and our second is for everyone to have fun.

Activities for Everyone...

- Pony Rides:** For children 12 and under (NO ADULTS). (1) Children must be accompanied by an adult. (2) Ponies are hand led by an Oil Ranch employee. (3) One rider at a time. (4) Please, only Oil Ranch employees in pony arena.
- Petting Zoo:** For all ages – everyone gets to go inside! Do not chase the animals! Disinfect hands after playing with animals.
- Dairy Barn:** An educational exhibit showcasing modern day milking procedures. This includes the process of taking the milk from the dairy to you. A Ranch employee will assist you in milking the cow. Be sure to Disinfect hands before and after.
- Hay Barn/
Animal Barn:** Play in the hay barn. Adults must supervise children at all times in this area. **Caution:** Allergic reactions to hay, peanuts, and dust may cause medical problems and should be considered when entering. These items are stored in Barn. Tour the side halls of the big barn and visit the baby animals (some animals are seasonal). *Please*, do not pick up the baby animals.
- Hamster
Wheel:** Take a roll in our hamster wheel. See if you can make it turn like a hamster would. Be mindful of those outside the wheel. Do not stand in front or behind the wheel. Do not push from the outside.
- Kid Hopper:** An in-ground jumping pillow. Shoes, watches, and jewelry must be removed. Must be physically fit, no somersaults, & **absolutely no jumping when Oil Ranch attendant is not present. No Jumping when wet.**
- Hayride:** Hand feed the cattle in the pasture. Do not get off of the wagon without the permission of the driver. **Caution:** *If you are pregnant, or have medical problems; the hayride is very bumpy. Remember to be polite and form a line. No cutting in line or holding someone's place in line.*
- Train Ride:** Board the O.I.L Express Railroad by the Windmill. Riders must stay seated and keep arms and legs inside the train at all times. Please be polite and form a line. No cutting or holding someone's place in line. **PLEASE do not walk on or cross train tracks.**

Mining** Panning for fossils and gemstones is fun for all ages!!! Purchase mining rough at Spring Creek Mining Station or at General Store.

Maze:** All ages welcome with adult supervision. Target shooting only. Goggles must be worn at all times in Gallery. Paintballs are for sale at the General Store or at the Gallery.
- Indian Village:** Located next to the Indian Village. Walk through the stockyard maze and see if you find all of the six flags over Texas.
- Mini-Golf** Explore and play among the Tepees, Totem Pole, the Indian Sky Swing, and Charlotte's Web.
- Playgrounds:** Please observe posted safety rules. Play all 9 holes of golf. Balls and clubs provided.
- Fun Fishing:** Do not let ANY child do anything dangerous, your child or not. Swings, Slides, Pillow Fight Pole, Bucking Barrel, Softball, Volleyball, Basketball, Tug-O-War, Sack Races, Horse Shoes.
- Other Info:** Fun for the whole family! Catch and release fishing. Bring your own bait, tackle, and pole.
- (1) Lunches may be eaten in a pavilion (if not reserved).
(2) Wagons may be used 10 minutes for free or can be rented for \$5.00 all day. Please return them to front gate after using.
(3) Water fountains are located by the pool and the lake restroom facility.
